

Ofelia García is Professor in the Ph.D. program in Urban Education at the Graduate Center of the City University of New York. Prior to that, she was Professor of Bilingual Education at Columbia University's Teachers College, Department of International and Transcultural Studies, and at The City College of New York.

She has also been Dean of the School of Education in the Brooklyn Campus of Long Island University. Her latest books include *Bilingual Education in the 21st century: A global perspective*, *Imagining Multilingual Schools* (with Skutnabb-Kangas & Torres-Guzmán), *A Reader in Bilingual Education* (with Colin Baker), and *Language Loyalty, Continuity and Change: Joshua Fishman's Contributions to International Sociolinguistics* (with Peltz & Schiffman).
