Outstanding Languages Educator Awards 2024

_Required documentation

A statement needs to accompany each category for which the person is nominated. This must be accompanied by three mandatory elements and at least two pieces of further evidence.

Mandatory elements:

- 1. A personal statement, written in the first person about your rationale for applying. In the case of another person nominating, a third person is accepted.
- 2. At least one piece of evidence of student classroom work (e.g. writing, performance, film, mp3 file etc.) with clear explanation of what it is and why you have sent it. It may, for example be a student response to a task you have designed (send the task description too)
- 3. Current Curriculum Vitae.

At least two pieces of further evidence: These may include:

- One supporting statement by an identified colleague or another person who can endorse your teaching, and/or professional support, in relation to the award.
- Detailed Lesson(s) or Program plans with clear connections to one of the award categories
- Further samples of resources you have created; learners' work samples; evidence of evaluation processes.
- Details of any professional development learning to which the nominee has

<u>contributed</u> in some way with outcomes for improved classroom practice, or professional relationships, as appropriate.

• Short video of your classroom practice

The panel will be looking for a description of what the applicant has done, how they have done it and what the outcomes have been for learners, colleagues, and the school.

Terms and conditions

- Teachers may nominate themselves or be nominated (with consent) by another educator
- Nominees must be a current financial member of MLTANSW (Individual or School membership)
- If applying for different categories of the award, nominees must apply separately for each one
- A maximum of one award will be awarded in each category
- The awards may not be granted if there are no suitable applications
- Nominees are asked to use the application form which can also be downloaded from the <u>MLTANSW website</u>
- Any supporting evidence that you wish to be returned must be clearly labeled with the applicant's name and contact details. A stamped selfaddressed envelope should be enclosed for the return of this supporting evidence
- Applications must be submitted by **17 May 2024 by 5 PM**. Winners will be notified and awards will be presented at the MLTANSW Conference on Friday 14 June 2024
- Late applications will not be considered
- The Principal from the school of each award recipient will be contacted
- Each application will be assessed individually, and recommendations made on merit, by a panel appointed by MLTANSW
- The decision of the panel will be final, and no further discussion will be entered into.
